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Stonebrooke Rehabilitation Center Earns Deficiency-Free Rating

NEW CASTLE, IN — Stonebrooke Rehabilitation Center has received a deficiency-free survey by the Indiana State Department of Health, which is now using tough new inspection standards.

Stonebrooke Rehabilitation Center, located at 990 N. 16th Street in New Castle, has received top surveys in the past, but this survey is the first in which the facility has received the highest score a nursing community can receive. No other New Castle area nursing communities have received this rating since the new survey process has been in effect.

Stonebrooke Rehabilitation Center Executive Director Keith Davis said taking good care of residents is a priority and the major reason Stonebrooke Rehabilitation Center has ranked so well.

“It is a great accomplishment for our team and a reflection of the care we give our residents,” said Davis.

Since becoming one of about 60 communities operated by American Senior Communities, Stonebrooke Rehabilitation Center has consistently received high customer satisfaction survey scores. In the most recent survey, 95 percent of customers said they would recommend Stonebrooke Rehabilitation Center to family and friends.

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The community was surveyed last month. The new federally-mandated Quality Indicator Survey has been implemented gradually across the U.S. It has two stages, the first of which requires in-depth interviews with residents, staff and others and a review of residents' medical records.

The second stage involves in-depth investigation of how well residents are assessed and how well care is planned and provided. The new process is more comprehensive.

Dan Benson, COO of American Senior Communities, said: "The Indiana State Department of Health is rigid in its standards. Surveyors go through the facility with a fine-tooth comb. Receiving a perfect score from surveyors really means something and is what we constantly strive to achieve. The thanks really go to the amazing staff and their strong focus on caring for the individual. Without that level of dedication they show every day, this wouldn't be possible."
